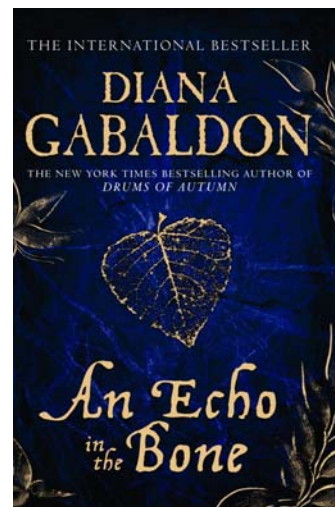
This is the outstanding seventh novel in the international bestselling phenomenon that is the Outlander series.
